The scenic byway is a 126-mile corridor that includes State Roads 40 & 19, County Road 445, and Forest Roads 62 & 29.

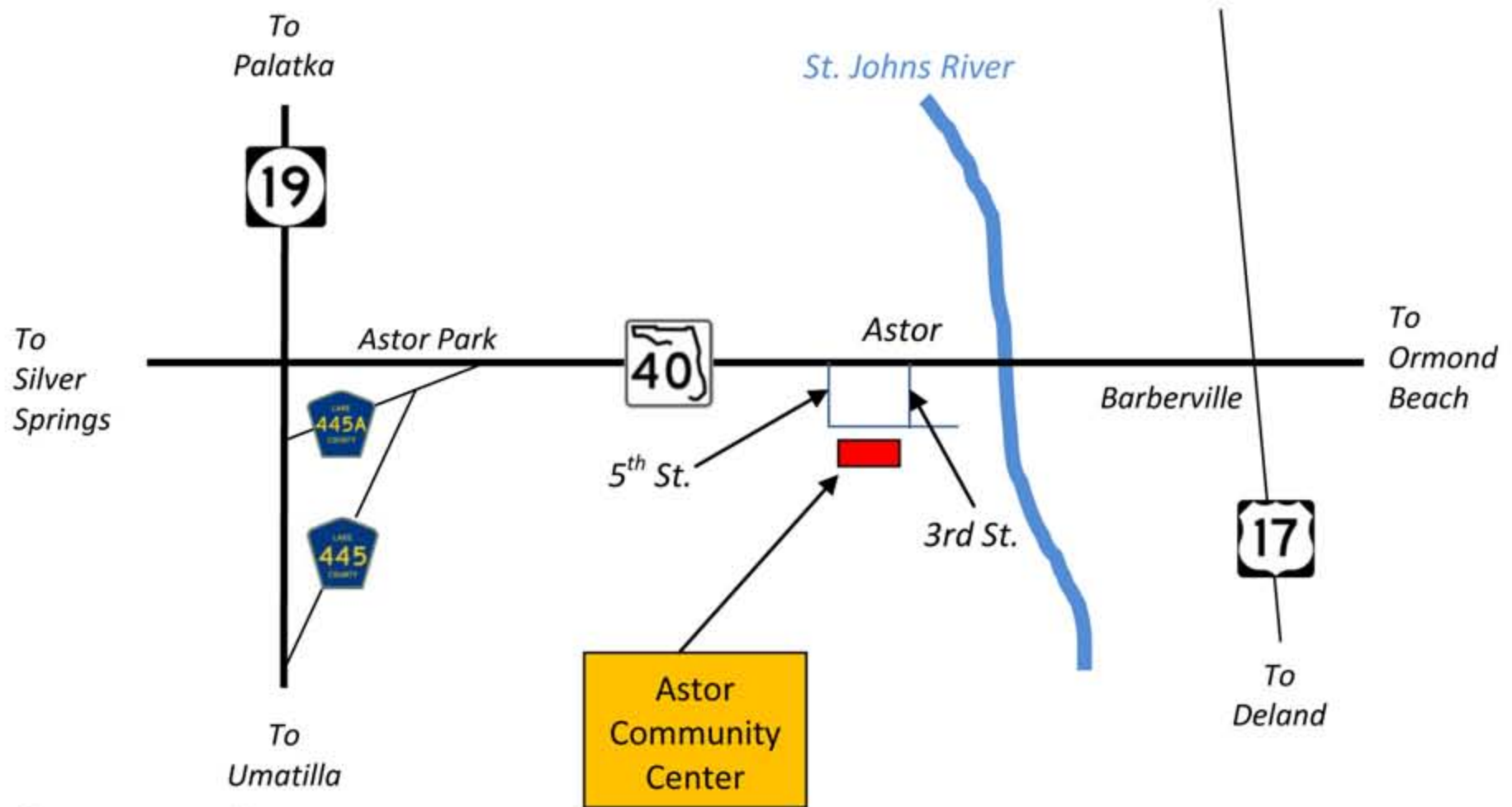

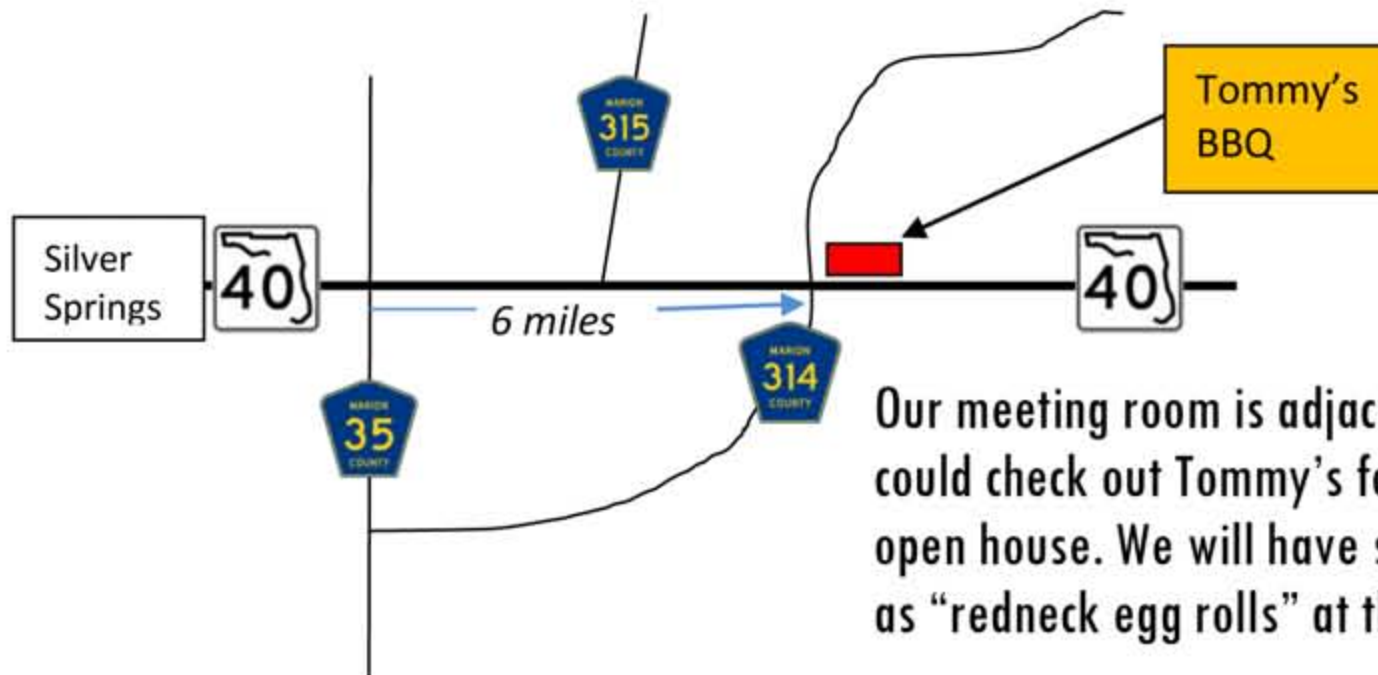
